

RESOLUTION NO. 1261-03-20

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NACOGDOCHES, TEXAS AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 418.108 OF THE TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE, DECLARING, CONTINUING AND EXTENDING A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER IN THE CITY OF NACOGDOCHES, TEXAS DUE TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY CREATED BY THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Texas Disaster Act, Chapter 418 of the Texas Government Code, allows the City of Nacogdoches to seek State aid in the case of a disaster defined as the imminent threat of epidemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2020, the Mayor issued a declaration of local disaster for the City of Nacogdoches due to the emergency situation posed by the spread of COVID-19 and advocating that certain emergency protective measures may be taken; and

WHEREAS, a declaration of local disaster activates the appropriate recovery and rehabilitation aspects of all applicable local or interjurisdictional emergency management plans and authorizes the furnishing of aid and assistance under the declaration; and

WHEREAS, Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code provides that a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period in excess of seven (7) days without the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision; and authorizes this Resolution declaring and extending a local state of disaster.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NACOGDOCHES, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The continuation and extension of a declaration of a local state of disaster is made by the Nacogdoches City Council on this the 26th day of March, 2020.


SECTION 2. The continuation and extension of the aforementioned declaration shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be promptly filed with the City Secretary as required by Section 418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code.

SECTION 3. This declaration will remain in effect until terminated by further action of the Nacogdoches City Council.

SECTION 4: This Resolution shall become effective immediately after its passage.


