THIRD DOSES

CDC recommends that people whose immune
systems are moderately to severely
compromised should receive an additional dose
of mRNA COVID-19 vaccine after the initial two
doses.

There is no booster for the J&J
vaccine at this time.

COVID-19 testing. Please make an
appointment with your preferred store
before going to get tested.
Individuals can also visit the City's
website nactx.us/covid19 to find a
testing facility.
